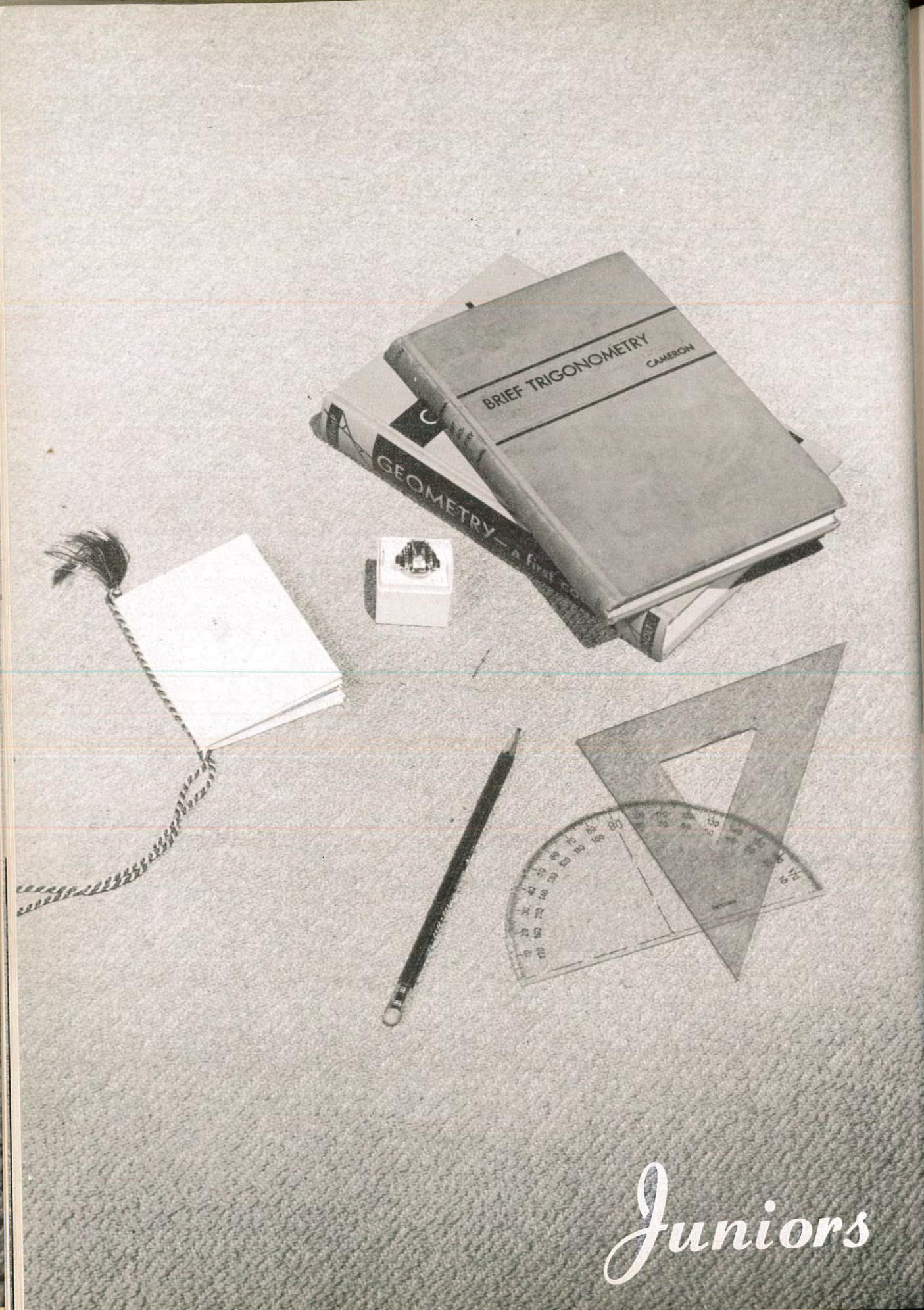
GLENN TYNER is a building firm executive, and his most recent contract is the building of a new civic auditorium in Nashville.
