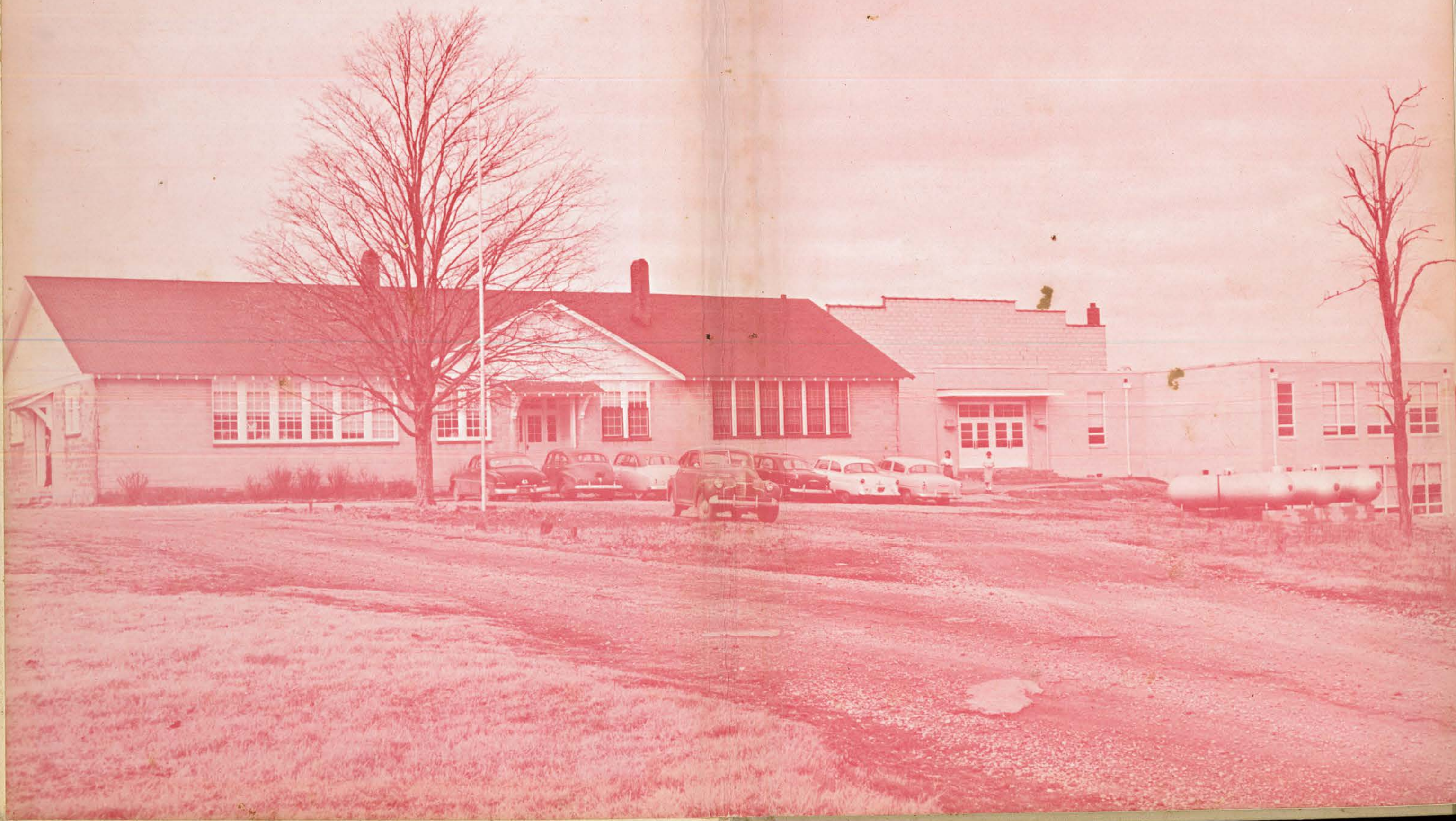

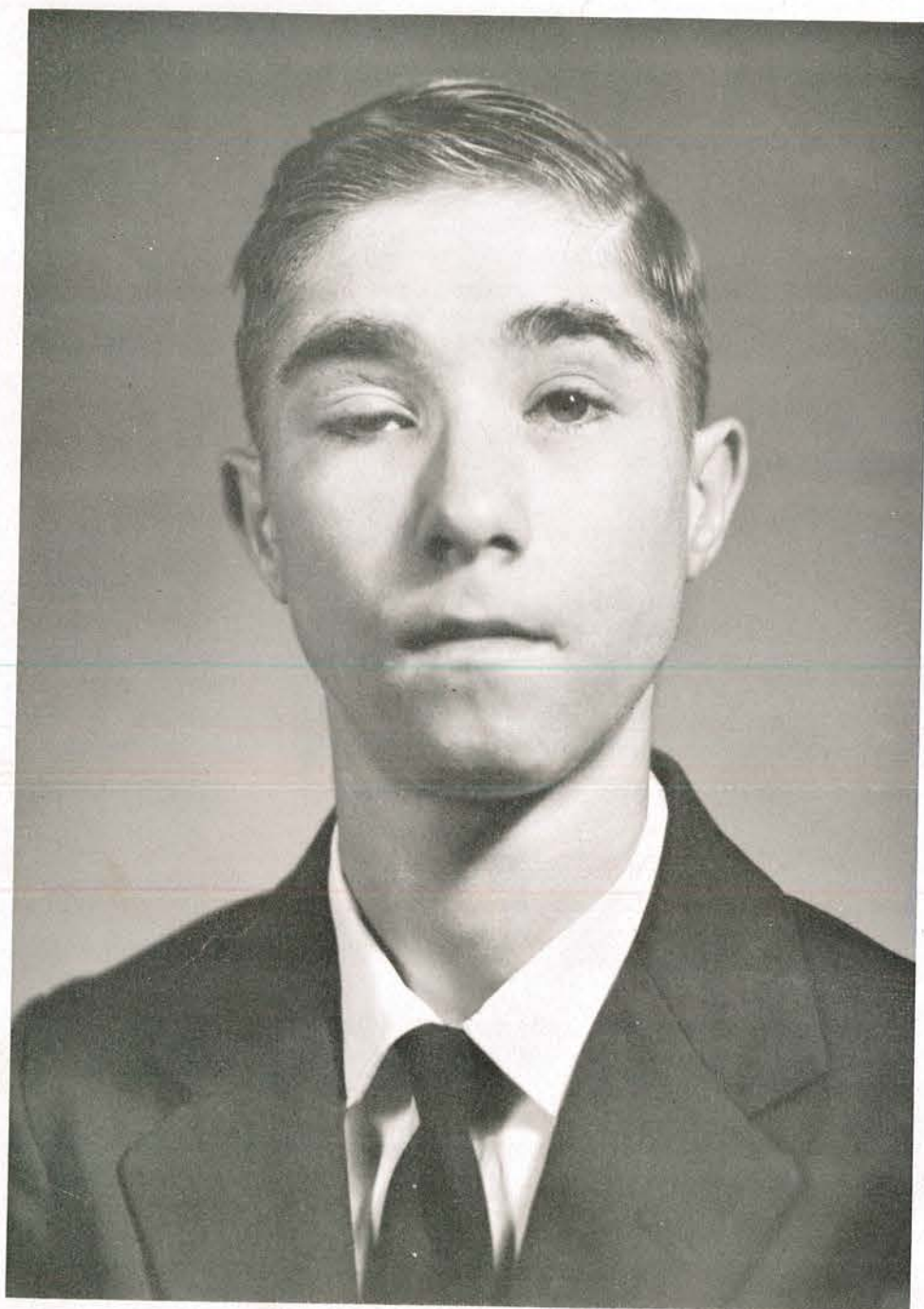

September was one of the most thrilling times of all, at last our class rings had arrived!

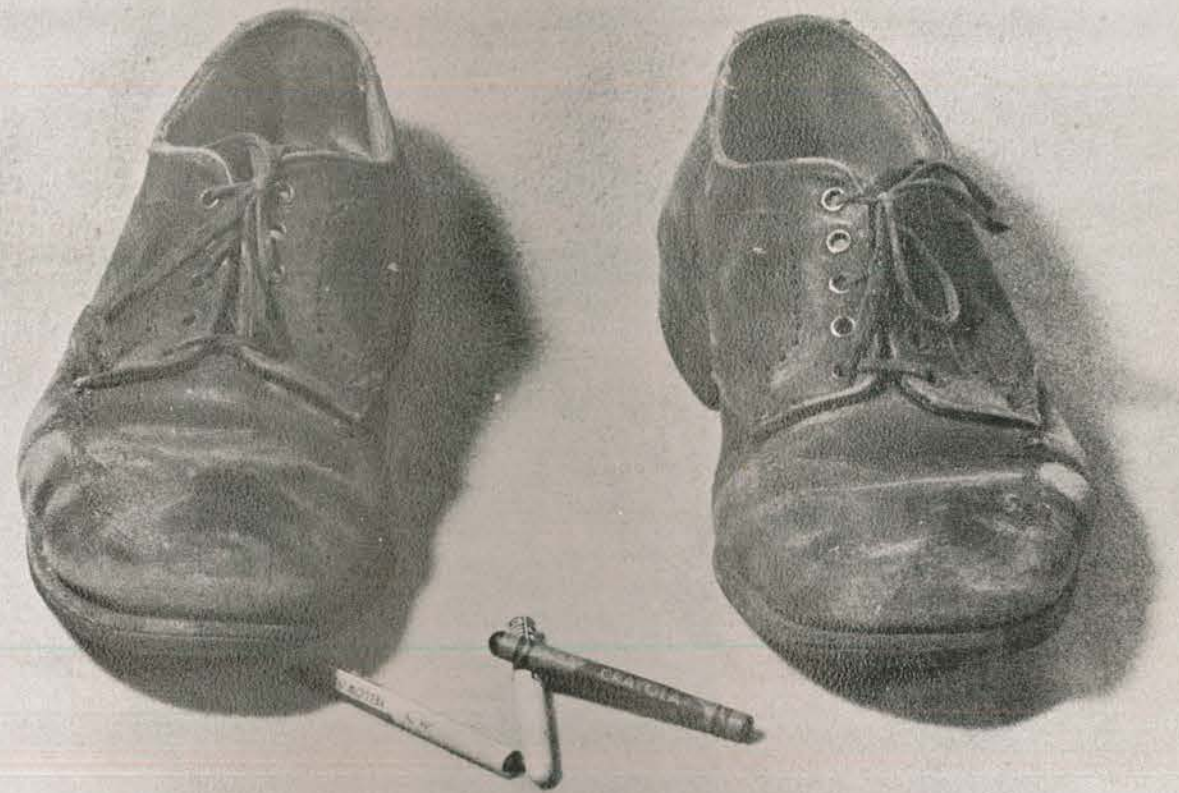

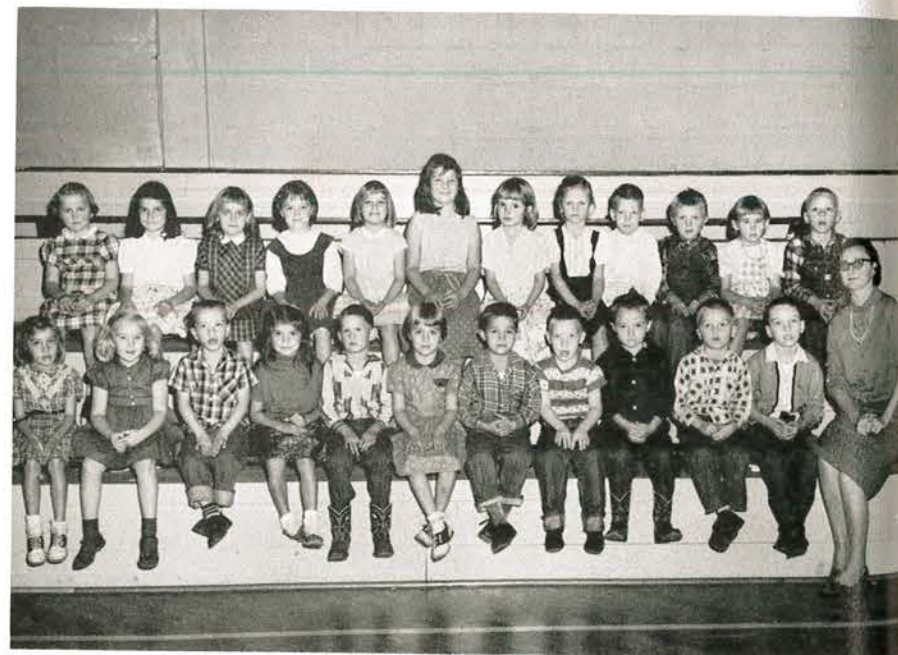
