### Class History

A hayride, two class parties, and a picnic at Montgomery Bell State Park were some of our activities of that year. Sue Martin and Benny Bowman were selected as our representatives to Girls and Boys State. Mrs. Thomas Benson was our sponsor.

At last we are Seniors! Our class has 22 members with everyone working hard toward graduation. For our Senior year our officers are as follows: Charlotte Southern, President; Louise Rust, Vice President; Belita Basford, Secretary; and Benny Bowman, Treasurer. September was one of the most thrilling times of all, at last our class rings had arrived!

With a happy heart and cheerful mind, we thank everyone who has helped us so much this year and all of our school years.
