We are looking forward to our Junior and Senior Banquet this year, and to Graduation.

As we stand together at Graduation to sing our "Alma Mater" we will look back on the past four years with pride and regret. It is all together fitting that we look back to recall our fond memories, but it is even greater to look forward to our future, a future made richer by the guidance and knowledge obtained at Hillsboro High School. May "Forward Ever be our Watchword" forever be our motto in life.

To the Sophomore Class and Freshman Class, we leave the aspiration to become Seniors.


