As our high school days are rapidly coming to a close, we look back over the past years and think of all the good times, as well as hardships, we have shared.

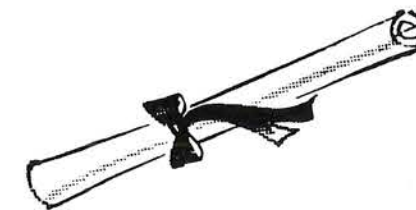

As we stand together at Graduation to sing our "Alma Mater" we will look back on the past four years with pride and regret. It is all together fitting that we look back to recall our fond memories, but it is even greater to look forward to our future, a future made richer by the guidance and knowledge obtained at Hillsboro High School. May "Forward Ever be our Watchword" forever be our motto in life.

I, Paul Tyner, do hereby will my charm, poise, tactfulness, good looks, and modesty to all the teachers at Hillsboro.

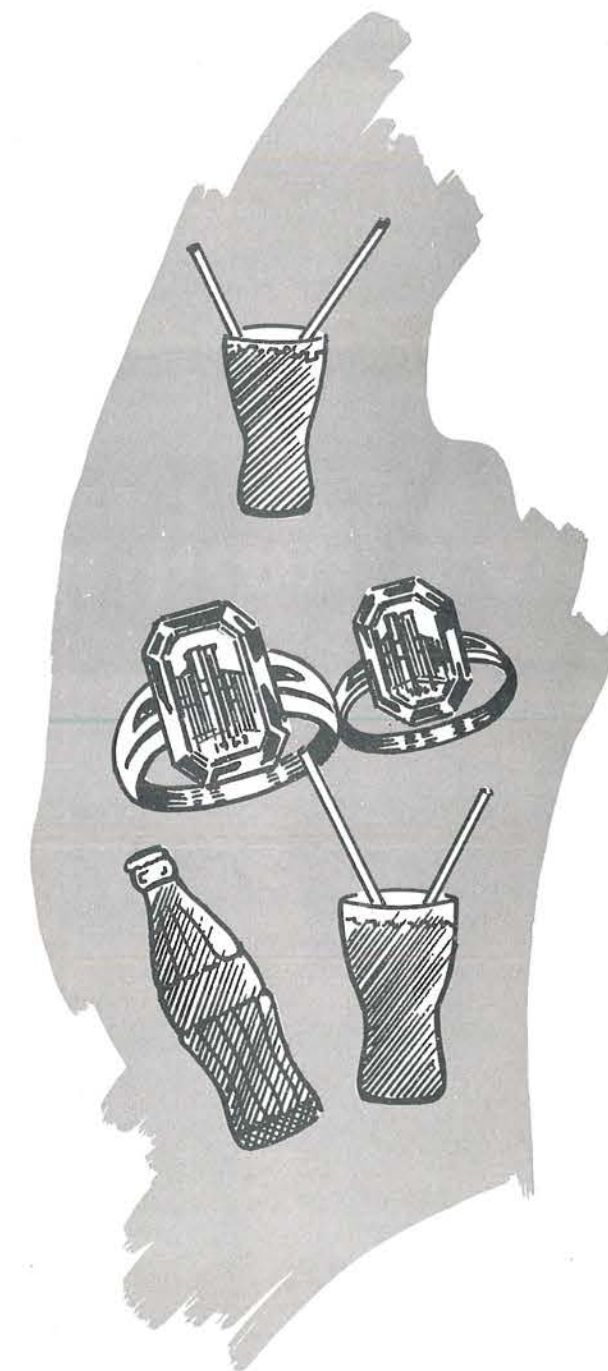
