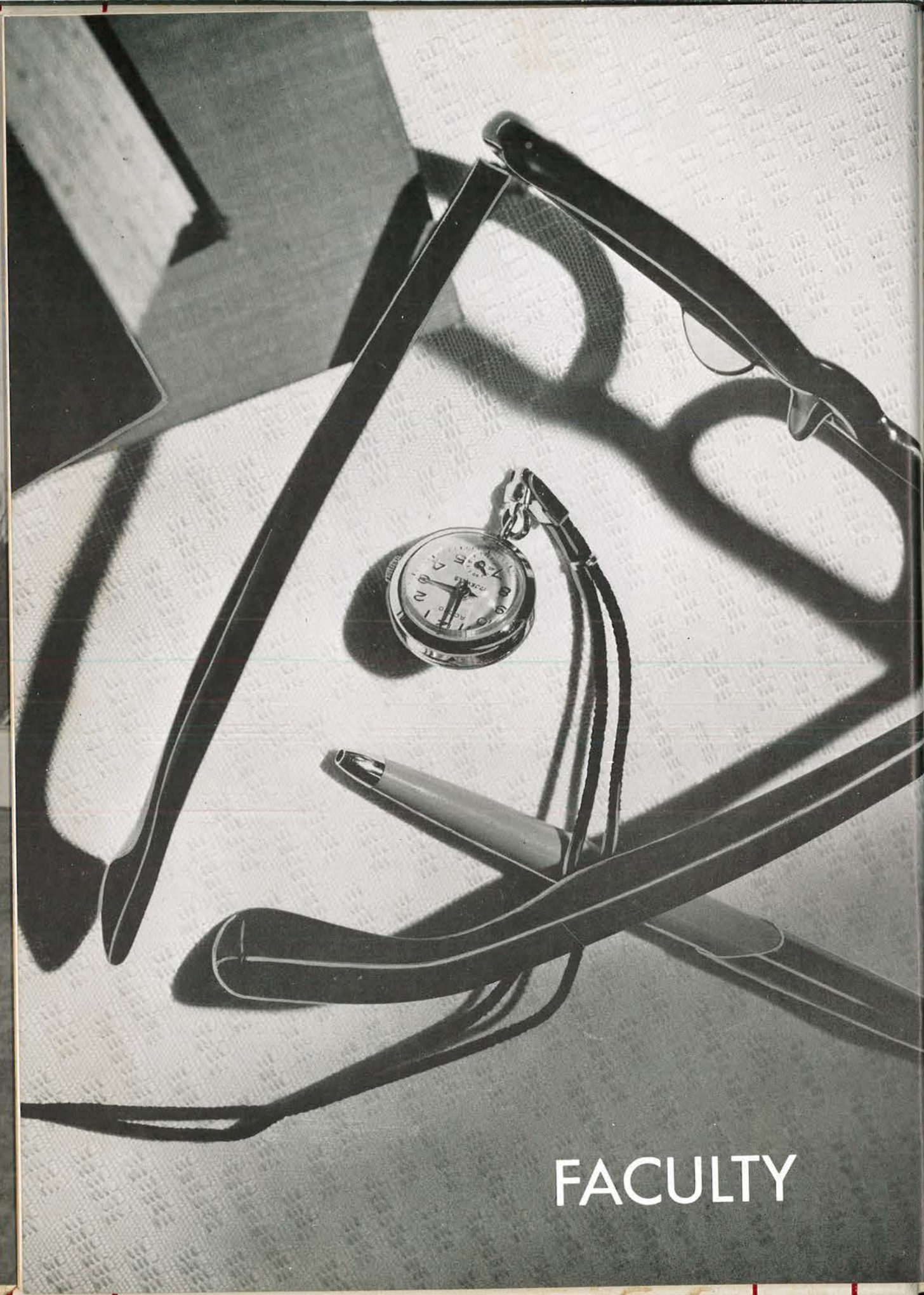
PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE TO THE SENIOR CLASS:

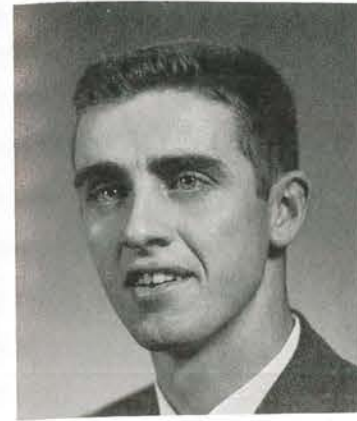
Just as in school, life has many honors and awards. There are also many challenges and problems. May you always strive to represent Hillsboro High School well, so that we will always be proud of you.
