"O Little Town of Bethlehem" was the theme of the Christmas play performed by Mrs. Smith's class.

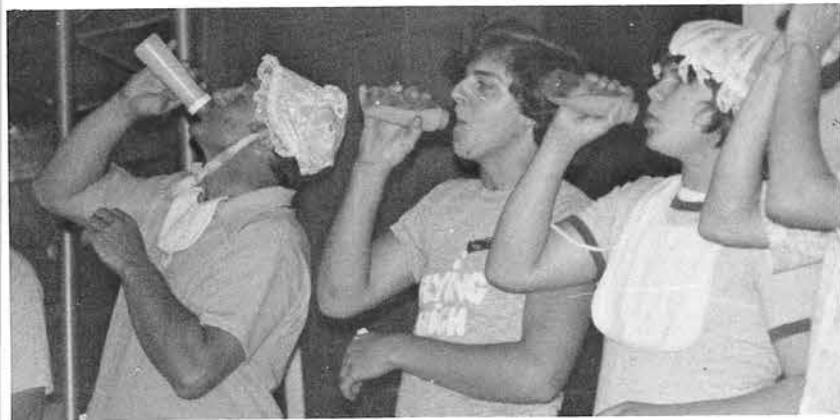
